Occasionally, students opt to mail/fax the paperwork after the event. GSEF will follow up with the student, parent, and teacher with reminders to send outstanding paperwork to claim award. After four reminders, unclaimed awards will be allocated to GSEF's general donation fund to support GSEF operations and future participants.
