The University of Georgia's Office of Academic Special Programs is seeking volunteer judges for this year's *Northeast Georgia National History Day Regional Contest* on **Saturday**, **February 8**, **2025**.

NHD breathes life into the traditional social studies curriculum and gets students excited about studying the past, conducting quality historical research, and analyzing information to draw important conclusions about humans and our world. The contest provides opportunities for middle and high school students to conduct historical research, deliver a presentation, receive constructive feedback, and advance to state and national competitions.

To compete in NHD, students select a topic related to this year's theme, *Rights & Responsibilities in History*, and engage in a program of research, using primary and secondary sources, designed to investigate their topic and answer specific research questions. Students then showcase their research in one of the following categories: *Exhibit*, *Paper*, *Website*, *Documentary*, or *Performance*.



NHD judges serve the critical role of evaluating student entries, providing helpful feedback, and selecting students to advance to the next level of competition.

Judging will take place at the University of Georgia Center for Continuing Education & Hotel in Athens, GA on Saturday, February 8, 2025 from 8:30 AM until about 2:30 PM. Orientation and lunch for judges will be provided.
